Janet Gibson Tate, 75, of 2556 Green Farm Road, Danville, VA, died Tuesday, September 6, 2022 at her residence after a decline in her health for the past five years.

Janet was born in Nowata, OK, on December 16, 1946, a daughter of the late James Russell Gibson and Lola Rivena White Gibson. She lived her early years in Oklahoma before moving to Danville, VA in 1979. She received her Master's in Education from the University of Oklahoma and a Master's in Business Administration from the University of Central Oklahoma. She worked as a teacher in Oklahoma and she retired from Danville Community College as a Grant Coordinator.
