June 2, 1929 - January 20, 2010

Janey Henderson Morris, 80, of 322 Cumberland Drive, died Wednesday, January 20, 2010 at her residence after a decline in her health for several years. Mrs. Morris was born in the Vernon Hill community of Halifax County, VA on June 2, 1929, a daughter of the late Roy Satterfield Henderson and the late Eva Mae Henderson. She was a graduate of the former Wilson Memorial High School in Halifax Co., Class of 1946 and a member of the High School Basketball Team.
