Our sweet Mother went home to be with her Lord and Savior on November 1, 2010. She had been residing at Roman Eagle Memorial Home for two and a half months at the time of her transformation to heaven. Prior to Roman Eagle she lived with her daughter Barbara Gregory, 6261 Irish Road Chatham, VA. for eleven years. Our Mother was born in Dillion, S.C. on May 29, 1908. She was the daughter of the late David R. Tucker and Minnie Herring Tucker. At the age of 102, she had seen many changes in this world.
