Jean Carolyn Eanes Scarce, 69, of Danville, VA went home to be with her Lord on Thursday, January 2, 2025 at her residence, after being in declining health for the last two years.

Jean was born in Danville, VA on January 20, 1955, a daughter of the late James “Jack” Eanes and Sadie Eanes Dixon. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she worked for Comcast for 29 years. After her retirement from Comcast in 2013 she worked part-time as a teller at First Citizens Bank until her health declined in 2022. She attended River of Life Church.

Jean cherished her children and, in particular, loved spending time with her grandchildren.

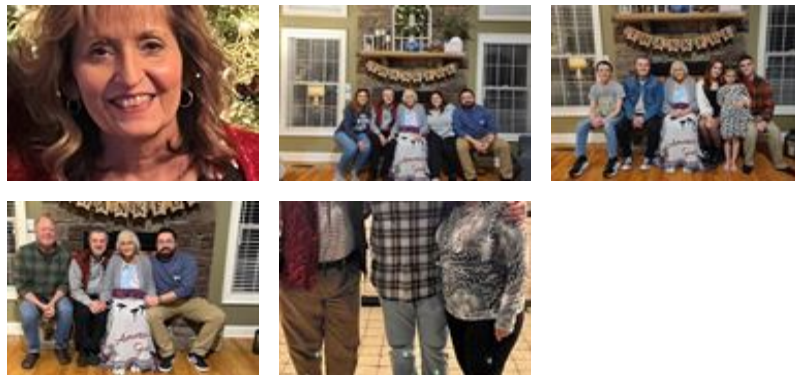
