Jeanette Davis Stowe, 97, died Sunday, January 29, 2023, at Roman Eagle Rehab and Health Care Center. Born July 6, 1925. She was the daughter of the late Joel Waller Stowe and the late Jeanette (Nettie) Davis Stowe.
