Jerrine Brown Walker, 87, of 1559 Kentuck Road, Danville, VA, died on Wednesday, February 8, 2017 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care Center after being in declining health for several years.

Mrs. Walker was born in Pittsylvania County on January 26, 1930, daughter of the late Harry Gordon Brown and the late Elma Warren Brown. She spent all of her life in the Pittsylvania County area where she graduated as valedictorian from Dan River High School, Class of 1947. She went to work as a librarian for several years at Dan River Elementary School then she became the attendance secretary at Dan River High School until her retirement. She was a very active member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church, where she taught Sunday school for many years. She also served as Treasurer for over 50 years and was a choir member. Mrs. Walker was also known for her love of bowling and was a member of the Danville Bowling Association Hall of Fame.

In 1950, she married Carroll "Jeff" Eston Walker, Sr. who died on January 10, 1999.

In addition to her parents and husband, a brother Ryland Brown predeceased her.
