Jesse Holden Felts, Jr, 84, of 207 Woodside Road, Danville, VA went home to be with the Lord on April 13, 2022 after a short decline in his health.

Jesse was born in Warrenton, NC on January 27, 1938 a son to the late Jesse Holden Felts and Lizzie Staton Felts. He had lived most of his life in the Ringgold Community and in Danville, VA. Jesse was a graduate of Dan River High School, Class of 1957.

Jesse had owned and operated the former Riverside Homes Inc. prior to his retirement. He had served with the Virginia National Guard as a Sgt. 1st Class. Jesse was a very active member of Central Blvd. Church of God where he served on the Pastors Council, as Usher & Deacon. He had worked as a leader of Boy Scout Troop, # 365 and was a member of the former Ringgold JC's for several years.
