



## Jimmy Bradley

September 11, 1937 - June 3, 2017

James Hubbard (Jimmy) Bradley, 79, of 463 S. Woodberry Ave., Danville, VA, died on Saturday, June 3, 2017, at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care after a decline in health for the past year.

Jimmy was born on September 11, 1937, in Danville, VA, a son of the late Willie Bill Bradley and the late Eunice Lee Mills Bradley. He lived all of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Virginia Carolina Tool Company and Wrenn-Yeatts Funeral Homes until his retirement. He was a faithful member of the former Keen Street Baptist Church, now United Baptist Church, and was a member of the Kent Masonic Lodge No. 305. He was an avid hunter and outdoorsman and a lifelong Virginia Tech Hokies fan.

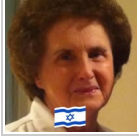

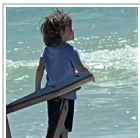
