



Jimmy Lee Fugate

April 15, 1939 - May 6, 2013

Jimmy Lee Fugate, age 74 of 224 Mangrams Road, Danville, VA, died at Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center, Winston-Salem, N.C. on Monday, May, 6, 2013 after a decline in health for the past month.

Mr. Fugate was born on April 15, 1939 in Blackwater, Virginia, a son of the late Elmer Fugate and the late Margaret Collingsworth Fugate. He served in the U.S. Army, and was employed by Yellow Freight System for twenty six years as a truck driver until his retirement. He was a member of Vandola Baptist Church. On November 20, 1958, he was married to Patsy Jones Fugate, who survives.
