John Anthony Gourley, 73, of Danville, passed away on Thursday, December 18, 2025 at the Hock Family Pavilion in Durham, NC. 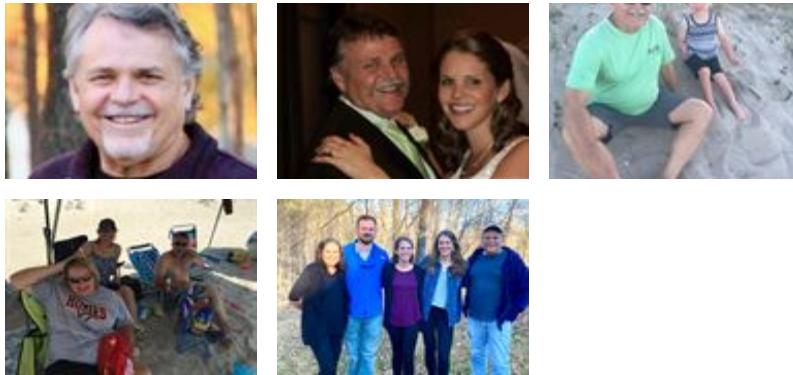
