Dr. Hall died on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care Center after a decline in health for several years.

He was the son of the late John R. Hall and Maxine Hall and brother to the late Rickey Hall.

He received a B.S. degree and Master's degree from Longwood University in Farmville, VA, M.B.A. from Averett University in Danville, VA and a doctorate from the University of Virginia in Charlottesville, VA.

Dr. Hall was Athletic Director at Hargrave Military Academy in Chatham, VA for eleven years. He also taught extension classes for the University of Virginia. He retired from Martinsville Middle School.

He was a veteran of the United States Air Force and was stationed at Upper Heyford in England.

John pastored several churches in Western North Carolina and later he attended Riveroak Church of God where he was very active in the music and drama departments.

He is survived by his wife, Rachel Hall; son, James Robert Hall and wife, Caite; grandchildren, Natalie Cheyenne Hall and Alexander James Hall of Cabot, AR.

Funeral services will be conducted on Sunday, February 19, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. at the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Roger Collins, the Reverend Garry Yeatts, and Mr. Jeff Dill officiating. Interment will follow the service in Highland Burial Park with military honors conducted by the United States Honor Guard.
