He was a retired plant superintendent of Southern Processors, Inc., but most importantly, he was a loving Husband, Father, brother, and friend. He was a faithful member of Woodlawn Baptist Church where he helped lead worship services with his voice and guitar.

On September 28, 1996, he married his loving wife, Rhonda Hylton Owen, who survives of the residence.

Along with his parents, his eldest brother, Preston Owen, predeceased John.

from where his passion grew. His love for music led him to be proficient in learning how to play anything he desired. Aside from his musical gifts, he was a man of many other talents.
