



John Whitlock

November 16, 1917 - March 17, 2011

Mr. John Whitlock, Jr., age 93 of 117 Berkley Street, died Thursday, March 17, 2011 in Chatham Health and Rehabilitation Center after a decline in health for three months.

Mr. Whitlock was born on November 16, 1917 in Ringoes, N.J., a son of the late John L. Whitlock and the late Eva Holcombe Whitlock. He had lived most of his life in New Jersey and moved to Danville in 1990. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II as a Medical Technician with the 94th Evacuation Hospital on the front lines in Africa and Italy. The hospital backed the troops in all four battles in the area. He made the invasions into Italy at Salerno and Anzio. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, bowling and square dancing. He was a member of Fairview United Methodist Church where he was a member of the Henry Hardy Fellowship Class and United Methodist Men. He was also a member of American Legion Post 325. He was first married to Edna Danforth Whitlock, who predeceased him of May 19, 1979 On May 3, 1980, he married Mary McGuire Whitlock, who survives.

In addition to his wife of the residence, he is survived by a number of nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by three sisters and one nephew.
