



Johnny Lee Foster

February 7, 1951 - April 9, 2018

Johnny L. Foster, of Danville, VA, died at SOVAH Medical Center in Danville, VA on April 9, 2018 after many weeks of being in the hospital. He was born February 7, 1951 in Pittsylvania County, VA to the late L.C. Foster and the late Ethel Foster. His early life consisted mainly of working on his parents' tobacco farm, along with attending school and church. He entered the military at a young age and served in the 82nd Airborne Unit of the U.S. Army. Johnny bravely fought for his country in the Vietnam War, which left scars seen and unseen for the rest of his life.

Along with his parents, two siblings, Leonard Foster and Juanita Barrett, predeceased Johnny.

One daughter, Destiny Crenshaw, and three grandsons, Elijah, Hayden, and Zander survive him. He also leaves behind three sisters, Edith Spraker, Mary Loftis, and Joan Deel; and two brothers, Jimmy Foster and Stewart Foster; as well as many nieces and nephews.

A graveside service will be held at the Virginia Veterans Cemetery, 10300 Pridesville Road in Amelia, VA on Thursday, April 12, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.
