February 24, 1921 - January 1, 2015

Joseph "Joe" Wells, 93, of 903 Main St. Apt. 2, Danville, went home to join his heavenly father on Thursday, January 1, 2015 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Center after being in declining health for the past four months.

Mr. Wells was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on February 24, 1921, son of the late Joe Starling Wells and Julie Kirks Wells.

Mr. Wells worked for Dan River Mills for 41 years in Production Control, and served in the U.S. Army during WWII. He was a member of Mount Hermon Baptist Church, Carter Lodge # 323 A.F. & A.M., and the American Legion Post 325.

Joe was a loving and devoted husband and father. He married the love of his life, Irene Jefferson Wells, on March 20, 1948, who survives.
