Joshua Blake Dabbs, 16, of Danville, VA, died unexpectedly on Tuesday, April 13, 2021.

Joshua was born in Danville, VA, on September 11, 2004, a son of Raymond “Ray” James Dabbs and Michelle Moore Dabbs. He spent all of his life in the Danville area where he was a Junior at Tunstall High School. He was also a student of VOC-TECH Precision Machine Program.
