Josh was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey Senior High School, Class of 2004. He earned his undergraduate degree from Appalachian State University. Josh has completed his Master's Degree from Liberty University and Ed. S Degree. He was also well into completing his PhD in Organizational Administration. Josh was currently employed with the Caswell County Public School System as a Science Teacher at Dillard Middle School. He was dedicated to the students of Caswell County where he was a friend and tutor to better their education. He was always involved in all sports activities with the students. Josh attended Providence Baptist Church.
