Joy Patterson Thompson, 80, of 254 Thompson Road, Pelham, NC went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, April 19, 2020 following a brief period of declining health. Joy's death was not related to the Coronavirus.

Joy was born in Danville, VA on January 1, 1940, a daughter to the late James Richard Patterson and Connie Robertson Patterson. She lived in Danville and Caswell County throughout her life. Joy was a graduate of George Washington High School, Class of 1958. She worked in Yanceyville for Lee Farmer & Stuart Watlington for several years prior to becoming a full time homemaker. Joy was a member of Bethel United Methodist Church where she loved singing with and for her church family. She was an accomplished artist, avid gardener and loved to watch British mysteries and classic black and white movies.
