Judith “Judy” Gail Farthing Alderson, 82, of Danville, VA went home to be with the Lord on Friday, February 9, 2024.

Judy was born in Danville, Virginia on April 1, 1941, a daughter of the late Eugene Thomas Farthing and Mozelle Farson Farthing. She was a 1982 graduate of Averett College where she received her Bachelor Degree in Liberal Arts, she then went on to work as a teacher for the Pittsylvania County School System from 1983 to 1998. She was a member of the former Third Avenue Christian Church.

Judy was a remarkable musician who was proficient in both piano and organ. She would perform at her local church, neighborhood funeral homes, and also conducted music lessons at her home.

On May 5, 1962 she married John Wayne Alderson who died on August 28, 2020.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was predeceased by her brother, Sherrill Farthing.
