Julia Nuckols Byrd, 72 of Danville, was reunited in Heaven on November 23, 2014, with her loving husband Robert O. Byrd Jr., of 58 years. They were married on August 25, 1956, and he preceded her on November 9, 2014.

Born in Whitsett, North Carolina on May 22, 1942, she was the daughter of the late Jay Ivan Nuckols, Sr. and Ione Graves Nuckols. She was predeceased by her brother Jay Ivan Nuckols, Jr.
