Julian Glenwood Tucker, 94, of 134 Elon Place, Danville died Sunday, February 24, 2019 at SOVAH-Danville.

He was born February 5, 1925 in Danville, a son of Elvin Clark Tucker and Elizabeth Wilborn Tucker. Mr. Tucker served his country first in the Navy and later the Air Force retiring after 20 years of service. He worked as an electrician for Corning Glass, retiring after 20 years of service.

Mr. Tucker was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church, the American Legion Post 325 (Life member) and the Improved Order of Red Men, Poquoson Tribe No. 124.

On February 4, 1961 he was married to the former Belva Lynch, who survives.

In addition to his wife, of the residence, he is survived by a son, Gary A. Tucker and wife, Mary of Danville; a daughter, Pamela Dawn Tucker of Cincinnati, OH; and four grandchildren, Miranda Estep, Caroline Tucker, Rose Tucker and Anna Tucker.
