



Julius Lee Clayton

January 20, 1918 - December 2, 2015

Mr. Julius Lee Clayton, 97, of 3724 Shady Grove Road, Providence, NC went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, December 2, 2015 after being in declining health for the past three weeks.

Mr. Clayton was born in the Leasburg Community of Caswell County on January 20, 1918 a son to the late George Lee Clayton and Leona Moorefield Clayton. He had lived his entire life in Caswell County where he had retired from the Caswell County School System. Mr. Clayton had taught School and served as Principal for Cobb, Dillard and Bartlett Yancey Elementary Schools for 34 years. He was a member of Shady Grove United Methodist Church where he had taught Sunday School, a choir member, a member of the United Methodist Men Group and a member of the Cobb Ruritan Club. Mr. Clayton served stateside during World War II as a pilot for U.S. Air Force. On June 29, 1949 he married Anne McDowell Clayton who died on October 12, 2009.

Mr. Clayton is survived by one son Bruce M. Clayton & wife Stephanie of Yanceyville, NC, two daughters Lee Anne C. Johnson & husband Steve, Julie C. Underwood & husband Kenneth all of Providence, NC, two sisters Geneva C. Williamson of Yanceyville, NC and Helen C. Somers of Reidsville, NC. He is also survived by four grandchildren, Stuart Clayton & wife Lesley, Jeremy Johnson, Clayton Johnson & wife Jordan & Katie Underwood, one great grandchild Matthew Clayton.
