Katherine Caroscio Myers, 72, of 6486 NC Hwy 62 North, Blanch, NC departed to her heavenly home on Monday, December 5, 2022 after being in declining health for the past several months.

Katherine was born in Elmira, New York on October 31, 1950, a daughter of the late Victor Alfred Caroscio and Mary Catherine Lochern Caroscio. She was an undergraduate of Cornell University and a graduate of University of North Carolina at Greensboro with a degree in Child Development. Katherine was employed by Caswell County School System and prior to being employed by the Person County School System where she worked in Child Development until her retirement. Katherine married Paul Houston Myers on April 12, 1980, who survives at the residence.
