



## Kathleen Elliott Stroud

February 16, 1926 - May 4, 2013

Kathleen Elliott Stroud, 87, of 648 Dover Place, Danville, VA, died Saturday, May 4, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center where she had been a patient for the past three weeks.

Mrs. Stroud was born in Schoolfield, VA on February 16, 1926, a daughter of the late Tobe S. Elliott and Mary Young Elliott. She had lived most of her life in Danville, VA and retired from Danville Plywood Corporation where she had worked as Office Manager.

Mrs. Stroud was a graduate of Brosville High School, Class of 1943 and she received a secretarial certificate from Averett College. She was a member of Fairview United Methodist Church where she was a member of the Henry Hardy-Fellowship Class and she loved visiting her homebound and nursing home friends.

On May 4, 1946 she married Robert Levi Stroud, who died January 18, 2006. Survivors include three sons, William Craddock "Bill" Stroud, of Lexington, VA, the Reverend R. Levi Stroud, Jr., and wife Tricia, of Woodbridge, VA, and John Elliott Stroud, of Raleigh, NC; two sisters, Louise Hogan, of Ringgold, VA, and Myrtle Searce, of Danville; three grandchildren, Heather Tompkins, and husband Rob, of Danville, Tamara Foster, and husband Graham, of Winston Salem, NC, and Caleb Stroud, of Woodbridge, VA; and a great grandson, R.J.
