Charles Keith Piercy, 53, of 761 Peach Orchard Road, Axton, VA died on Saturday, February 15, 2014 at Hospice Home of Alamance after being in declining health for the past five years.

Keith was born on March 15, 1960 a son of Charles Henry Piercy and Bonnie Inez Walker Piercy of Danville, VA. He spent all of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Inter Tape Polymer Group. He was a member of Faith Memorial Baptist Church.
