Kenneth "Doc" Holland, 85, of 2064 Whitmell School Rd, went to be with his Lord and Savior on his 85th Birthday, August 27, 2012, after a decline in health for the past two months.

Born on August 27, 1927, in Pittsylvania County, VA the son of the late Charlie Franklin Holland and Hattie Blanche Wells Holland.
