Larry Wayne Burner, 66, of 1793 Barker Road died suddenly at Danville Regional Medical Center Emergency Department on Saturday, February 13, 2010. Mr. Burner was born on June, 21, 1943 in Harrisonburg VA, a son of the late Layton Brown Burner and Ruth Burner Willson, who survives. On November 26, 1964, Mr. Burner married Nancy Bowman Burner, who survives.
