Larry Hugh Talbott, 59, of 300 Gallery Road, Axton, VA, died Tuesday, February 10, 2015 at his residence after a decline in his health for the past two years.

Mr. Talbott was born in Fauquier, VA, on November 4, 1955, a son of the late Baker Lee Talbott and Mary Francis Talbott. He lived most of his life in Axton, VA and Danville, VA. He was a member of Central Baptist Church, Axton, VA, where he served in several church activities and he was an avid fisherman.
