



## Laurence Woodard Jr.

July 1, 1932 - January 16, 2017

Laurence Woodard, Jr., 84, of 221 Martin Dr., Axton, VA died on Monday, January 16, 2017 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past five years.

Mr. Woodard was born in Epping, New Hampshire on July 1, 1932, a son to the late Laurence Woodard, Sr. and Grace Lena Guyette Woodard. He spent most of his life in New Hampshire before moving to Axton in 2004. He was a veteran of the United States Army who served in the Korean Conflict. He was a member of the V.F.W. Post 7 of Rochester, NH, and the Disabled American Veterans.
