Lawrence Earl Crews Jr, 78, of 2553 County Home Road, Blanch, NC went home to be with the Lord on Friday, November 22, 2024 at Moses Cone Hospital after several months of declining health.

Earl was born in Danville, Va. on July 20, 1946, son of the late Lawrence E. Crews Sr. and Lena Shelton Crews. He was a graduate of the former Helena High School in Person County. Earl received a degree in Agriculture from Piedmont Community College. He was a former member of the V.F.W. in Yanceyville and member of the Yanceyville Ruritan Club.
