Lemma Crumpton Hart Blackstock of Danville passed away peacefully on January 12, 2026 at the age of 101.

She was born in Caswell County, North Carolina, on June 6, 1924, to the late Eli Loyd Crumpton and Bertha Gentry Crumpton.
