Lester Thomas “Buck” McMinnis, Sr. 93 of 4253 Stoney Mill Road, Danville, VA died on Monday, June 9, 2014 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past two months.

Mr. McMinnis was born in Pittsylvania County on December 2, 1920 a son to the late Bennie R. McMinnis and the late Maggie Dalton McMinnis. He lived most of his life in Danville, Virginia. Mr. McMinnis served during World War II with the US Navy Sea Bees. On December 25, 1946 he married Dottie Robertson McMinnis who died on August 29, 2006. Mr. McMinnis worked for the Danville Public School Board in maintenance until his retirement. Prior to his employment with the Danville Public School Board he worked for numerous construction companies. He was a member of Vandola Baptist Church.

Survivors include: two sons, Lester Thomas (Ted) McMinnis Jr. of Franklin, Tennessee, Mark Kevin McMinnis and wife Reena of Danville, VA; Three daughters, Joan M.
