Martha Elizabeth “Lib” Allen Lassiter, 92, of 4115 Blanch Road, Blanch, NC went home to be with the Lord on March 20, 2017 in Duke Medical Center after being in declining health for the past several months.

Mrs. Lassiter was born in the Blanch community of Caswell County on November 9, 1924 a daughter of the late Berkley Felix Allen and Ismer VanHook Allen. She had lived all of her life in the Blanch community. She was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey High School, class of 1941, where she was Valedictorian of her class and she graduated from the Averett College Business program. Mrs. Lassiter had retired from the Caswell County Agricultural Extension Service where she worked as a secretary. She also worked as secretary at Bartlett Yancey High School for a number of years. Mrs. Lassiter was an active member of Blanch Baptist Church where she served as treasurer for many years, choir member and was president of the W.M.U.

Elizabeth kept young with her many interests. She was an excellent cook and seamstress, being a member of Blanch Homemakers Club. She spent many years as a member of VFW Ladies Auxiliary 7316.
