Lillie Ann (Edwards) Bartley, resident of Danville, Virginia passed away on December 28, 2012, at her home after a decline in health over the past several months.

Ann, as she was known by most, was born on the 19th of June, 1941 in Danville, VA to George and Lula Edwards. She was predeceased in death by both her parents and one brother, George Edwards, Jr.
