Linda Gayle Toler McKinney, 73, of 409 Lansbury Dr., Danville, VA, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Thursday, April 2, 2020, at Roman Eagle Health and Rehab after a decline in health for the past few years.

Mrs. McKinney was born in Pittsylvania County, VA, on May 31, 1946, a daughter of the late Johnny Lester Toler and the late Gladys Matilda Brooks Toler. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she worked for over thirty-eight years for Dan River, Inc. After retiring from Dan River, Inc., she worked for Roman Eagle Health and Rehab for five years. She was a member of Riverview Baptist Church.

She is survived by her husband, James Martin McKinney, of the residence; three bother-in-laws, John McKinney, Sr., Raymond Maxey, and Bud Staley; two sister-in-laws, Donna McKinney Hodges, and Betty Lattmore; an aunt, Cindy Vines; and a number of nieces and nephews.
