Lisa Turner Barbour, 60, of 402 Hundred Acre Road, Ringgold, VA, died Friday, April 16, 2021 at SOVAH Health in Danville after a decline in her health for the last six months.

Lisa was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on December 10, 1960, a daughter of the late Russell Norman Turner and Katherine Farthing Turner. She lived her entire life in the Danville area and was a graduate of Danville Christian School, Class of 1979. She was a homemaker and had been retired, due to disability, since 2012.

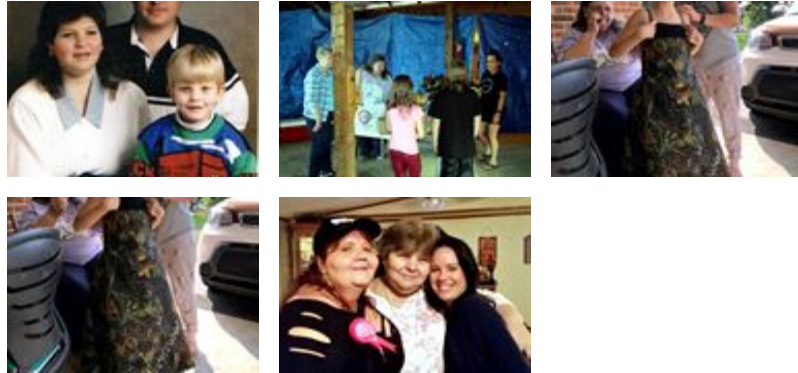
