Annie Elizabeth Gammon Custer, 90, of 2780 Vandola Road, Danville, VA departed this earthly life for eternal life on Wednesday, March 15, 2017 at Moses Cone Hospital in Greensboro, NC.

Mrs. Custer was born on January 20, 1927 in Danville, daughter of the late S.L. Buck Gammon and the late Pearl Beggerly Gammon. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she worked for Dan River Mills for 42 years until her retirement. She was one of the first charter members and the last surviving charter member of Westover Hill Pentecostal Holiness Church where she taught Sunday school for over 40 years. She enjoyed photography, flowers, and loved Elvis but more than anything, she loved her grandchildren and great grandchildren.

On November 12, 1947, she married George Onyx Custer who died on November 9, 2006.

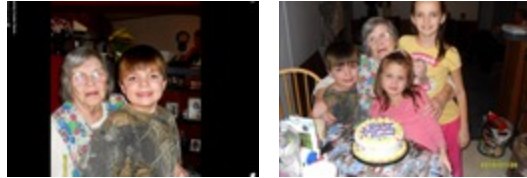
