May 10, 1933 - June 23, 2025

Lois Burton Shelton, 92, of Dry Fork, VA, died Monday, June 23, 2025 at her residence after a decline in her health for the past twelve months.

Lois was born in Danville, VA, on May 10, 1933, a daughter of the late Willard Montague Burton and Viola Gibson Burton. She lived her early years in Danville, VA, and she moved to Dry Fork, VA in 1951 when she was married.

Lois was a homemaker and farmer. She was a member of Hopewell Church, where she was a choir member for over 60 years, a Sunday School Teacher, and a member of the United Methodist Women.

On December 19, 1951 she married Robert L. "Bobby Lee" Shelton, who died on August 4, 2023.

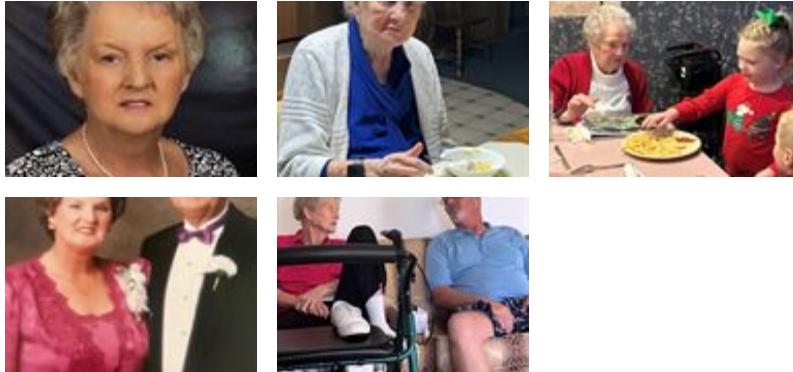

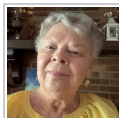
