Lola Brumfield Tanis, formerly of 157 Gough Street, died Sunday, January 31, 2010 at Piney Forest Health Care Center after a decline in her health for the past three months. Mrs. Tanis was born in Ringgold, VA on February 17, 1926, a daughter of the late Richard A. Brumfield and the late Mamie Hayth Brumfield. She was the youngest of nine children and the last surviving member of her generation. She had lived her life in Pittsylvania County and Danville, VA.
