



## Lorena Hardy Adams

December 9, 1917 - February 25, 2016

Lorena Hardy Adams, 98, of 12505 Old Richmond Road, Keeling, VA, died on Thursday, February 25, 2016 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home after a decline in health for the past two months.

Born on December 9, 1917, in Keeling, VA, she was the daughter of the late Vester W. Hardy and Betty Dodson Hardy. She lived most of her life in the Keeling Community and retired from the Star Paper Tube. Mrs. Adams was a charter member of Kentuck Presbyterian Church where she taught Sunday School. She was also active with the Presbyterian Women's group and the Keeling Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary. Mrs. Adams was married to the late Wilson Burnett Adams who preceded her in death in 1973.

Mrs. Adams is survived by a two sisters, Betty H. McLaughlin of Keeling, VA and Audrey H. Walker of Ringgold, VA; and many nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was predeceased by brothers, L. Alton Hardy and William P. Hardy.
