Louis Herman Hodnett, 81 of Danville, VA, died on Saturday, August 22, 2020, at Stratford Health and Rehab after a decline in health for the past two years.

Mr. Hodnett was born in Halifax County, VA, on October 4, 1938, a son of the late Herman Dexter Hodnett and the late Callie Cordilla Hodnett. He lived all of his life in the Danville area and worked for the North Carolina Department of Corrections. He was a member of United Baptist Church where he served as a deacon.
