



Louise Elliott Hogan

January 20, 1921 - August 6, 2013

Cora Louise Elliott Hogan, 92, of 1260 Ringgold Church Road, Ringgold, VA died on Tuesday, August 6, 2013 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home, where she had been a resident for two months following a recent decline in health.

Mrs. Hogan was born on January 20, 1921 in Danville, VA, a daughter of the late Tobe S. and Mary Young Elliott. On November 21, 1941 she married the love of her life, Ovid Ramsey Hogan with whom she shared her life for almost 60 years until his death in 2001.

Mrs. Hogan spent most of her life in the Ringgold area where she retired from Dan River Mills, Hylton Hall. She was a long time member of Kentuck Baptist Church where she served as a Sunday School teacher, Choir member and member of numerous committees. She was well known and loved in the Kentuck community for her thoughtfulness and kindness to others. She was a long time member and past Worthy Matron of the Robertson Bennett Chapter #70 of the Order of Eastern Star.

In addition to her parents and husband she was predeceased by her brother, Franklin Elliott and sister, Kathleen Stroud.
