



Louise Tate Hupp

November 30, 1923 - February 21, 2013

Louise Tate Hupp, 89, of Piney Forest Health Care and formerly of Ringgold, VA died on Thursday, February 21, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for the past five years.

Mrs. Hupp was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on November 30, 1923 a daughter of the late Samuel Tate and the late Mamie Burgess Tate. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she worked at Dan River Mills until her retirement. She was of the Baptist faith.

Mrs. Tate was married to Rawley Hupp who predeceased her on July 22, 1989.

Survivors include two sons, Larry Hupp and wife Martha of Providence, NC and James Hupp and wife Edith of Danville, VA; three grandchildren Richard Hupp and wife Tabitha, Adam Hupp and Sarah Hupp Williamson and husband Thomas; and one sister Myrtle Dawson of Ringgold, VA.

She and her sister are the last survivors of fourteen siblings.
