Mr. Loyd Kenwood Dudley, age 91 of 3050 Joy Circle, passed away at his residence early Saturday morning, January 21, 2012 after a decline in health for two years.

Mr. Dudley was born on January 25, 1920 in Rocky Mount, a son of the late Todd I. Dudley and the late Annie Mae Dudley Spangler.
