



## Luther Felix Lewis

October 19, 1934 - May 27, 2016

Luther Felix Lewis, 81, of 3232 Westover Drive, Danville, VA, died Friday, May 27, 2016 at his residence. He had fought a courageous six year battle with Acute Myeloid Leukemia and had a decline in health in the past month. He was born in Danville, VA, on October 19, 1934 a son of the late Charles Cabel Lewis and Myrtle Simmons Lewis and lived his entire life in Danville, VA. He retired in 1998 from Nestle where he worked in the maintenance department, and prior to Nestle, had worked at Dan River Mills and Disston. He was a member of Rivermont Baptist Church, where he served as a Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, Usher and as a Choir Member. He was an avid gardener and loved growing roses.

On May 1, 1959 he married Marie Jefferson Lewis, who survives.

In addition to his wife, of the residence, he is survived by three daughters, Vickie Holman, and her husband Tim, of Danville, Kelly Blackwell, and her husband John, of Graham, NC, and Beth Cooke, and her husband Doug, of Danville; four grandchildren, Graham Holman, Will Holman, Greyson Cooke, and Nick Cooke, all of Danville; three brothers, Clarence Poe Lewis, and wife Florence, of Danville, John Lewis, and wife Geraldine, of Danville, and Paul Lewis, and wife Barbara, of Myrtle Beach, SC; and several nieces and nephews.
