



## Malcolm Price Jones

January 28, 1919 - December 14, 2012

Malcolm Price Jones, 93, of 50 Dallas Ave, Danville VA died on Friday, December 14, 2012 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home after a decline in health for several months.

Mr. Jones was born on January 28, 1919 in Pittsylvania County a son of the late Samuel Price Jones and the late Jennie P. Hall Jones. He lived all of his life in the Danville area where he worked at Hartman and Neal Tire Co. until his retirement. He served his country in the US Army during WWII and he was a member of Grace Design United Methodist Church. He was also a member of the improved order of Red Men Poquoson Tribe 124 for more than 50 years.

Mr. Jones was married to Emily Price Jones who died on June 15, 1998 and then on May 16, 1999 he married Rachel Langford Jones who survives of the residence.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Jones is survived by one son, Jimmie Price Jones (Robbie) of Gumsprings, VA; two step children, Lisa H. Stewart (Scott) of Danville, VA and Vernon J. Hosier, Jr. (Grace) of Chesterfield, VA; one brother, Harvey N. Jones of Staten Island, NY; eight grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

He was predeceased by one daughter, Sue J. Chaney; one son, Tommy Hartman Jones; one brother, Johnny Jones; and two sisters, Frances Geizentanner and Alice Wrenn.

Funeral services will be conducted on Sunday, December 16, 2012 at 2:30 p.m. at Grace Design United Methodist Church with the Reverend Kameron M. Wilds officiating. Interment will follow the service in Leemont Cemetery with military honors conducted by the US Army.
