



## Mamie R. Marshall

October 3, 1921 - December 31, 2020

Mamie Wiles Rowe Marshall, 99, of Blairs, Virginia, passed away on December 31, 2020 at her beloved home.

Mrs. Marshall was born on October 3, 1921 in Baltimore, Maryland, daughter of Elder Joshua Tillman Rowe, Sr. and Mary Elizabeth Wiles Rowe. She graduated from Western High School and Baltimore Business College. She worked at Gillman School until her marriage on January 5, 1943. She traveled to Waycross, Georgia where Mr. Marshall was stationed as a Military Policeman. Following his discharge from the Army, they relocated to outside Danville in Pittsylvania County. Mrs. Marshall was Guidance Secretary at Dan River High School from 1968 through 1988.
