



## Mamie Neal Pruitt

August 10, 1928 - January 10, 2015

Mamie Neal Pruitt, 86, formally of Avalon Drive Danville, died Saturday, January 10, 2015 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation & Health Care Center where she had been a resident for the past year.

Mrs. Pruitt was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on August 9, 1928 to the late Marvin Milton Neal and Clara Lee Patterson Neal.

Mrs. Pruitt spent most of her life in the Providence Community where she was a member of Providence Baptist Church before moving to the Westover Community in 1995.
