Margaret "Lee" Jeffress Cobb, 70, of 6977 Park Springs Road, Pelham, NC went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, August 9, 2016 in Moses Cone Hospital after being in declining health for the past two years.

Mrs. Cobb was born in Danville, VA on January 20, 1946 a daughter to the late John Daniel Jeffress and Juanita Van Hook Jeffress.
