Margaret Sorgee Heater, 75, of 1357 Westover Dr, Danville, VA died on Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at her residence after being in declining health for six months.

Mrs. Heater was born in Lynchburg, VA on April 2, 1938 a daughter of the late Talmadge Sorgee and the late Magdeline Stone Sorgee. She spent most of her life in the Danville area where she worked for the Danville Police Department as a School Crossing Guard for 28 years. She also worked for Becky's Kiddie College for over 18 years. She was a graduate of George Washington High School Class of 1956.

Mrs. Heater was a member of Woodlawn Baptist Church where she was a Sunday School Teacher. She was a life member of the Town and Country Garden Club and she also enjoyed volunteering with the Danville Museum of Fine Arts and History.

On March 21, 1959 she married Jack Allen Heater, who died on August 9, 2011

In addition to her husband she is survived by one son, Jay Allen Heater, and wife, Lisa, of St. Augustine, FL; two daughters, Jayne Ellen H. Oravec, of Danville, VA and Joan H. Covington of Clarksville, VA; and five grandchildren.

A graveside service will be conducted on Friday, June 14, 2013 at 11:00 A.M. at Danville Memorial Gardens with the Reverend Ronnie Brown officiating.
